FROM THE PASTOR

Today we hear about two widows. In the First Reading, a widow runs into the great prophet Elijah. He asks for some water and some pastry-like concoction. She remarks that she has only a little water and oil, she'll cook it for herself and her son and after eating it, they will die. Elijah promises her that if she gives it to him, the flour and oil will last throughout the drought. In the Gospel, a widow is spotted by Jesus and his apostles at the temple placing two coins in the treasury box, which was her whole livelihood.

These two widows gave everything they had. Their examples had to be on Jesus' mind as he hung on the cross that Friday afternoon.

This is our **Youth Ministry's Discipleship Weekend**, and we're very proud of our juniors and seniors who have worked so hard to plan this incredible spiritual experience with our Youth Ministry staff and the adult team. I always say that our "secret sauce" is the large number of adults who help out with the Youth Ministry. They're great role models for the teens.

Our Family Faith Formation team is introducing the various liturgical ministries to our grammar school students during this week's FF Breakout **Sessions**. They will also learn about altar serving, lectoring, children's choir, hospitality, and liturgical dance. This will also give their parents a chance to be reintroduced to these ministries which center around our Eucharistic celebrations - the heart of our common life.
