

FROM THE PASTOR

Today is **Gaudete Sunday**, when the third pink candle on the Advent wreath gets lit. Like Laetare Sunday (the 4th Sunday of Lent), it is a Sunday of joy in an otherwise penitential season. Gaudete Sunday gets its name from this day's old Latin antiphon, "Gaudete in Domino, Semper," meaning "Rejoice in the Lord, Always."

One of the most important events of Advent is our Pardon and Peace Service on Monday evening beginning at 7:00pm. It's a chance to look at reconciliation issues in our lives and in our relationships. Clearly, it's the ultimate moment in our Christmas preparation. We'll also be joined by a number of extra priests that evening for individual confession. Confession is also available after 9am daily Mass & on Saturdays from 3:30-4:45pm. You're also welcome to call me or Fr. Rich if you'd like to make an appointment for confession, for this is one of the most important aspects of our ministry, and we welcome the opportunity.

Our **Family Nativity Story** will take place during the homily at next Saturday's 5pm Mass, a joyous event for the entire family!



Sunday, December 15, 2024 The Lord Is Near



Today's readings: Zephaniah 3:14-18a; Isaiah 12:2-3, 4, 5-6; Philippians 4:4-7; Luke 3:10-18. On this Third Sunday of Advent, also called Gaudete Sunday, the second reading and the entrance antiphon proclaim, "The Lord is near." On Gaudete Sunday, a rose-colored candle is lighted on the Advent wreath, along with two purple candles from the previous two weeks of Advent. The purple candles symbolize our prayer and preparation; the rose candle symbolizes our joyful anticipation at the halfway point of Advent.

In today's first reading, the prophet Zephaniah speaks of the restoration of Jerusalem after the nation's sinfulness. He

invites us to not be discouraged, but rather to "Shout for joy . . . / Sing joyfully" and "Be glad and exult with all your heart." The faithful today, like the people who approached John the Baptist in the Gospel, are filled with expectation.

This week, to continue preparing your heart for the full joy of Christmas, dedicate time every day to pray. As St. Paul suggests in his letter to the Philippians, "with thanksgiving, make your requests known to God." Begin your prayer by expressing your joy and gratitude to God. How will the Lord's nearness inspire you to share your kindness with others? End your prayer by resting in the peace of God.

With the year drawing to a close, now is a time when many parishioners offer a year-end gift to Presentation, making the most of their donation thanks to various tax benefits. The deductions allowed by the IRS for charitable giving help individuals grow their generosity and help our parish continue its mission.

Did you know that...

- *You don't have to use cash to make your gift donate appreciated securities instead. The deduction is the same as for a cash gift, and you pay no capital gains tax on the transfer.
- *You can also transfer your Required Minimum Distribution to Presentation directly without having to pay income tax on the transfer. Simply coordinate for a "Qualified Charitable Distribution."
- *Give an asset that may help us more than it's helping you such as a life insurance policy whose coverage your family no longer needs, or real estate like a second home or a parcel of undeveloped land, or valuable collections or artwork you no longer have room to display.
- *You can make a gift that costs you nothing during your lifetime name your parish as a beneficiary of your will or revocable trust, or of your retirement plan.
- *You can make Presentation a partner in your givingyou can deed us your home but continue to live there.
- *Will my employer match my gift? Many companies offer to match an employee's gift, but there may be an issue with matching gifts to religious institutions. If you have a question or issue regarding matching gifts, contact Bob Rooney.
